Hodgman & Sons, Incorporated, and to its successors the Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said W. Hodgman & Sons, Incorporated, and to its successors and assigns forever.
