To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

Joshua Guedry, private, Captain, Bealls' Company, 3rd Regiment Louisiana Volunteers,

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in his favor, numbered 2029, for 40 acres,

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto William A Cloud, Assignee, of said Joshua Guedry, and to his heirs, the North East quarter, of the South East quarter, of Section, Twenty Three, in Township, Twenty Two, North of Range Two, West, in the District of Lands Subject to sale, at Ouachita, Louisiana, containing thirty nine acres, and eighty one hundredths of an acre

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said parts of said section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

William A Cloud, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
