Whereas, William Combs Cloud, of Gallatin County, Illinois,
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Shawneetown,
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Combs Cloud,
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Nine, in Township
forty South, of Range eight East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at
Shawneetown, Illinois, containing forty acres,
according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said William Combs Cloud;

several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said
William Combs Cloud, and to his heirs the said tract above described:
To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said
William Combs Cloud, and his heirs and assigns forever.
