KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

William, F. Cloud, Sergeant, Captain Sathams, Company, Second Regiment, Ohio Volunteers,

having deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** a **WARRANT** in *his* favor numbered *55,08*

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *Henry Kuhns, assignee,* of said *William F. Cloud*, and to his heirs, *The South West* quarter, of *Section Twenty four,* in *Township, Seventy two* North, of *Range Fifteen, West,* in the *District of Lands* Subject to sale at *Fairfield Iowa.* Containing, *One hundred and sixty acres*

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said *Quarter* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

Henry, Kuhns, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
