THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847. *George W. Lloyd, late a Sergeant in Captain Gillet's Company, First Regiment Texas Mounted Volunteers,*

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in *his*, favor, numbered *24,965.*

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *Adam Kerns Senior, assignee of said George W. Lloyd, and to his heirs, the West half of the North West quarter of section twenty five, and the South half of the North East quarter of section twenty six, in Township fifty seven, of Range thirty three, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Plattsburg, Missouri, containing one hundred and fifty seven acres and sixteen hundredths of an acre,*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tracks have been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *parts of said Adam Kerns, and to his,* sections of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

heirs and assigns forever.

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
